SCOPE OF THE WORKSHOP:

- **18 October 2021: Identifying and extracting publications from your research**

Postgraduate research takes many years and covers a lot of ground. Consequently, it becomes challenging to identify the right content for a publishable and interesting journal article. The first phase of this workshop series will help you to identify suitable content from your postgraduate research in order to produce a relevant and compelling article.

- **19 October 2021: How to write and structure a journal article**

Once you have identified appropriate content that you would like to turn into a journal article, it is then important to restructure your research according to journal article expectations. This session will explore different journal article forms, approaches and conventions that you can possibly adopt. In addition, we will discuss how you can structure and edit your ideas in ways that make your research stand out and establish you as an expert in your field.

- **20 October 2021: Where to submit your article**

This leg of the workshop will help students identify suitable journals in order to ensure the integrity and acceptance of their submissions. It is important to be strategic about where you send your articles, and this session will unpack what that means in the academic world. Moreover, predatory journals are on the rise, and are more likely to target students who have little experience in the field. This session aims to bring awareness to the 'business' of publishing that can be strategically leveraged in your favour.

- **21 October 2021: Dealing with Feedback**

You have worked extremely hard on your journal article, and waited months for an article review, only for it to come back rejected. This experience can be extremely demoralising, yet this workshop will provide coping mechanisms for dealing with rejection and provide tools on how to understand, work through and execute feedback for revisions and resubmissions.
